### **2. BODYWORK**

#### 2.1 General

- (a) period body kits are allowed

#### 2.2 Internally

- (a) Safety equipment and cosmetic or comfort accessories may be added.
- (b) Additional instruments and switches are permitted and may be fitted to a separate panel.
- (c) The seats may be replaced with a non-standard seat that is commercially available

### **3. ENGINE**

- (a) It is permitted to add baffle plate/s to the removable section of the engine oil pan or sump.
- (b) Each condenser, ignition coil, filter element, spark plug, lead, fan belt, radiator hose and gasket is free.
- (c) Rods and pistons are free
- (d) Head work is free
- (c) Period engine swaps are allowed

### **4. EXHAUST**

Exhaust if free

## **5. TRANSMISSION**

Gearbox is free, no sequential or paddle shift unless from factory

Clutch linings are free, as is their method of attachment.

## **6. BRAKES**

Brake linings and rotors are free.

## **7. SUSPENSION**

(a) It is permitted to adjust the wheel alignment in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations and/or normal wheel alignment principles.

(b) Coilovers are permitted

(c) Adjustable arms are allowed

## **8. FUEL**

Only Commercial Fuel in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual is permitted.

## **9. WHEELS AND TYRES**

(a) Wheels are free

(b) Tyres Only tyres which are compliant with the Production Car Tyre List for Speed Events in Schedule E of the Motorsport Australia Manual are permitted to be used. Tyre size must comply with the original manufacturer's specifications in respect to width and aspect ratio.
